Runt- an animal unusually small of its kind; especially: the smallest of a litter of pig
Injustice- absence of justice: violation of right or of the rights of another: <u>UNFAIRNESS</u>
Manure- material that fertilizes land; especially: refuse of stables and barnyards consisting of livestock excreta with or without litter
Snout- a long projecting nose (as of a swine) (2): an anterior prolongation of the head of various animals (as a weevil):
Captivity- taken and held as or as if a prisoner of war b (1): kept within bounds: <u>CONFINED</u> (2): of or relating to captive animals captive breeding
Litter- the offspring at one birth of a multiparous animal
Peered- to look narrowly or curiously; especially: to look searchingly at something difficult to discern
Trough- a long shallow often V-shaped receptacle for the drinking water or feed of domestic animals b : any of various domestic or industrial containers
Slops- food waste (as garbage) fed to animals
Vanished- to pass quickly from sight
