

1.	Secure- assured in opinion or expectation : having no doubt	
2.	Alders- any of a genus (Alnus) of toothed-leaved trees or shrubs of the birch family that have catkins which become woody, that typically grow in cool moist ground, and that have wood used especially in turnery	
3.	Thrashing- to beat soundly with or as if with a stick or whip	
4.	Anxiety- painful or apprehensive uneasiness of mind usually over an impending or anticipated ill	
5.	Midsection- a section midway between the extremes	
6.	Ascend- to move upward	
7.	Rummaging- to make a thorough search through
